Enjoy Life to the Fullest and Cherish what God has given You.

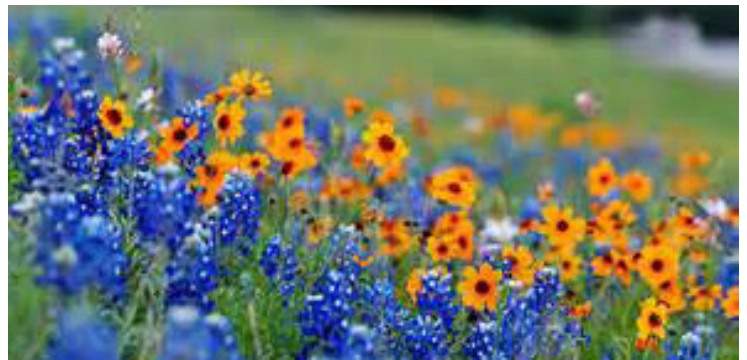
