## **Book Donation Update**


Jannell Bullock shared with us a thank you card that was received from AmVet 1000 and acknowledged the success of the 5th Annual Veteran's Day Luncheon.

or gently used for children up to 12 years of age. Books may be left with Neva Pratt or Debbie Barron.


